Coins Count – Save Those Coins!

This year's SD MCC Sale on July 10 will include Coins Count which supports WATER AT SCHOOL in Nicaragua where students don't have a safe water supply. Your coins will help construct new wells at some schools and repair existing water systems at others. With these improvements, students will have the water they need to drink and wash their hands. \$25 helps to repair a school water system; \$130 provides a carbon water filter for one school; \$1,400 is the average cost of one complete well for a school in Nicaragua. Let's see how many schools we can help secure clean water!
